


INSERTING SHELL-CLAD CLIPS






SHELL-CLAD FITTINGS

- Mid wall pillarsOctagonal and square pillars
- 3 Usually end of store walls
 Also used to "frame" graphics
- 5 Internal corners Octagonal pillars only
- 6 External corners
 Octagonal pillars only
- 7 Wall ends Octagonal pillars only
- 8 Diagonal (135°) corners
 Octagonal and square pillars
- 9 Internal "floating" corners Usually square pillars
- 10 Wall ends Usually square pillars



INSERTING SHELL-CLAD CLIPS


Clip into place by squeezing arrow head at one end and gradually pushing into the shell scheme groove (See Fig 1 & 2)



Gentle pressure may be necessary but this can be achieved by hand, ie no tools are required.

Do NOT aline a full length and force into position.

The bottom Shell-Clad clip should be rested on the pillar base otherwise your Shell-Clad will be visible above your graphics.



REMOVING SHELL-CLAD CLIPS

Squeeze the arrow head at one end, twist either clockwise or anti-clockwise and pull out of shell scheme.

WARNING: Shell-Clad has right angled (sharp) edges. Please be careful not to cut yourself when working with this product.

Shell-Clad is designed to attach graphics and similar lightweight materials to a shell scheme. Do not attempt to hang heavy objects with Shell-Clad.
